



I conveyed to Timothy Pickering, Samuel Hodgdon Duncan Ingraham Junr. & Tench Cox on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of October 1785 the above described Tract of Six hundred and seven Acres & Eighty seven perches & Allowance of six P. Cent Situate about half an Mile N. W. of where the path leading Venago Crosses Sandylick and on both sides of said path in Northumberland County By Warrant for 600 Acs N<sup>o</sup>. 242 dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1785.
