Surveyed the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1793 In Pursuance of a Warrant Dated Jan<sup>y</sup>. 30<sup>th</sup> 1786.

Note the Warrant to James Galbraith Jun<sup>r</sup> and James Mc Clelland calls for 400<sup>as</sup> but no more than 177<sup>as</sup> 1/2 could be surveyed by reason that the land therein described had been previously appropriated to George Duffield & Agness Latta by virtue of their Warrant dated the 28 day of February 1785 & 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 1785.
