



In Pursuance of a Warrant for 218 Acres of land dated the 24th day of April 1816, was surveyed the 20th day of June A.D. 1816 for Martha Wilday - the above described tract of land containing two Hundred Eighteen acres, one hundred fifteen perches and allowance of six per cent. for Roads &c. situate in Mead Township Crawford County Pa and at the time of making said survey, the said Martha Wilday and her husband Daniel, was living on the same, and there appeared to be upwards of twenty acres of land — cleared fenced and in good state of Cultivation, a house &c
