



Surveyed at the Special Request of Joseph Cook on 30<sup>th</sup> day of November 1793 two hundred and forty acres & 54 perches of Land & Allowance of Six per Cent &c. by virtue of an Improvement Began 2<sup>th</sup> day of November 1793 ~ and on the 18 day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1794 Resurveyed four hundred & twenty seven acres & 54 1/2 of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent at the Request of Joseph Cook and James Buchanan in pursuance of a warrant granted the said James Buchanan the 13 day of June 1794 Situate in District No 8 NW of the Allegheny River
