 ance of a warrant granted to John McCrea for 400 Acres Dated the 14<sup>th</sup> Day of  
 April 1792 Situate north and west of the River Ohio on the west Bank of Big  
 Beaver Creek adjoining Land granted to James McCrea Called Clay Pool Con-  
 taining four Hundred and thirty five Acres together with the usual allowance  
 of six per Cent for Roads
