



Pursuant to Act dated the 16th day of September 1808 Surveyed on the 6th day of October 1808 to Philip Shubert, Michael Tibbens, John Tibbens and Benjamin Tibbens the above and herein after described Island situated in the River Schuylkill in Roxborough Township in the County of Philadelphia called Killdeer Island opposite the Lands of John Holgate and the Widow Lake on the Eastern shore and opposite to the Lands of Anthony Levering and Paul Jones on the Western shore of ^{the} said River Beginning at the most Westerly corner at the head of the said Island thence North twenty seven degrees and fifteen minutes East seven perches and nine tenths to a stone set for a Corner thence South thirty five degrees and thirty minutes East forty five perches and four tenths thence across the lower end of the said Island South eighty eight degrees and fifteen minutes West six perches thence North ~~forty~~ ^{obliterated} degrees West six ^{perches} and one tenth and thence North thirty two degrees and fifteen minutes West twenty two perches and six tenth parts of a perch to the place of Beginning Containing One Acre three quarters and ten perches, or one Acre ^{obliterated} 0. perches strict measure.
