



The Draught of a Tract of Land situate part in West Pennsborough and part in Dickenson Townships Cumberland County containing forty-one Acres and a Quarter and Allowance of six Cent for Roads &c. Being part of two Tracts of Land formerly Surveyed into the Surveyor General's Office viz the small Triangle is a part of a Tract surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant to Robert Dunning dated Dec<sup>r</sup> 1<sup>st</sup> 1739 and contains Two and a Quarter Acres. The other part marked A is part of a Tract of Land surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant to John Dunning dated September 8<sup>th</sup> 1755 and contains thirty-nine Acres and thirty-four Perches & Allowance of six Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed and divided off for Wm<sup>l</sup> Ferguson the Seventh day of March 1791.
