



The Draught of a Tract of Land situate part in West Pennsborough and part in Dickenson Townships. Containing One hundred and forty two Acres and 119 Perches and Allowance of six Percent for Roads Sea being part of two larger Tracts of Land formerly Surveyed and Returned into the Surveyor Generals Office Viz No 1 is part of a Tract surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant to Robert Dunning dated December first 1739. and contains Sixty five Acres and 21 Perches and allowance.

No 2 is part of a Tract surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant to John Dunning dated September eighth 1755 and contains Seventy seven Acres and ninety eight Perches and Allowance of six Percent for Roads Sea.

Surveyed and divided off March 27th 1791.
