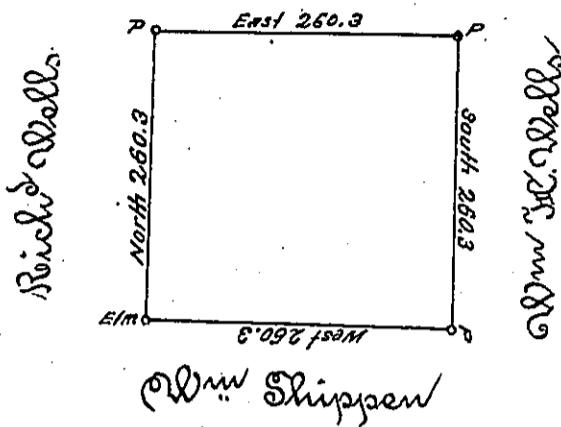


Donation



The above is the draught of a survey made May 14th 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Dorsey on the 25 April 1793 — situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the waters of Beaver Creek — adjoining land granted to William H. Wells called Orleans — containing 400 acres with the usual allowance of 6 per cent &c
