



A Draught of a Tract of Land called *Reich's Smith's* situate on *Chickshining* which empties into the North East Branch of *Disqueh* River on the West side thereof between *Wining Falls* & *Waphallapane* in the County of *Northumberland* adjoining land surveyed for *Simon Armstrong* and *John Parkinson* on said Creek containing three hundred & twenty eight Acres besides the usual allowance of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ Acs for Roads &c. surveyed the 24th Day of November 1773 for *Reich's Smith* in pursuance of an Order dated the 3rd Day of April 1769 Number 2081.
