 an interest in said survey by virtue of a contract between him and Patrick McQue  
 whose Assignee he is and by virtue of an Improvement & Survey in the name of Jas Scott  
 and of a warrant of acceptance thereof Issued the 7<sup>th</sup> August 1795 - -
