



In pursuance of an Application N^o 4148 dated August 29th 1769, with an Order of Survey annexed Surveyed by Anthony Crothers late Deputy Surveyor the 19th day of November 1794 to Joseph Seely, agreeable to the Original lines and boundaries thereof, the above described Tract of Land, Situate on a Stream that empties into Lackawanna Creek above the Falls, and including an open Meadow, called "Trunk Meadow" in Wayne County, Containing Three Hundred and eleven Acres and one quarter and Allowance of Six per Cent. Examined and Certified by me this 22nd day of May 1801
