 Surveyed on application N^o 3603 dated the 3^d July 1769 in the name
 of Mary Street. And Resurveyed on the 8th day of June 1833 by William
 Laird then Deputy Surveyor of said County by virtue of an Order of the
 Board of Property dated 21st February 1825 granted to Thomas Pollock
 Adam Hart, Eleanor Hart and Mary Pollock containing twenty one
 acres and sixteen perches and the usual allowance of six per cent
 clear of any interference with a survey in the name of Henry Shoemaker
 which was surveyed on a Warrant dated the 7th of September 1774.
