



Situate on Dickson Boggs township about five miles above the Bald Eagles nest on the north side of the Bald Eagle creek containing forty eight acres fifteen perches and allowance of six per cent (being part of a larger tract surveyed for Ralph Nailor the 17th of June 1770 by Thomas Smith then D.S. by order N^o 1540 dated the 3rd of April 1769) divided as above the 12th day of January 1828
