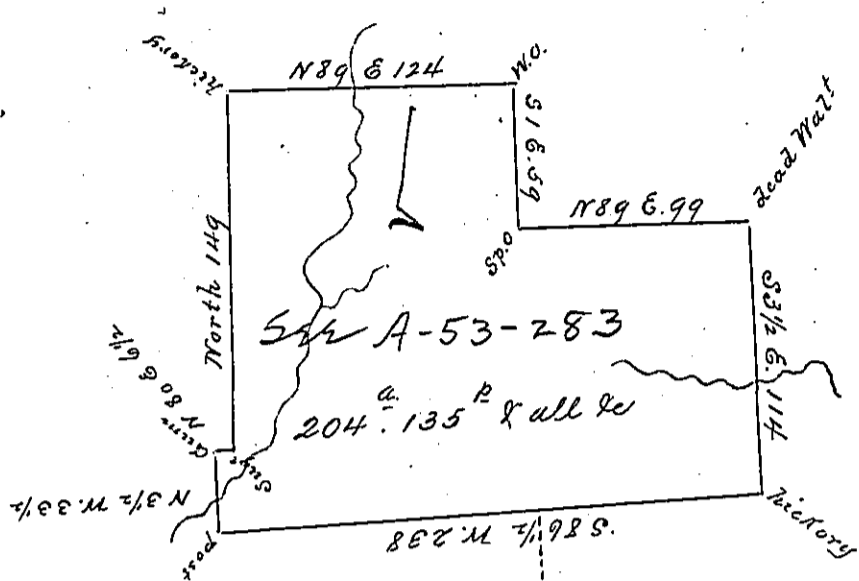

Draft of a tract of Land surveyed the 4th May 1809 for the heirs of Samuel Taylor, to wit, James Crawford & Mary his wife, late Mary Taylor, Sarah Taylor, Hugh Taylor & Nancy Taylor, situate in Pitt township Allegheny County, on the head waters of Turtle Creek, containing two hundred & four acres, one hundred & thirty five perches & allowance of six per cent for Roads &c. being part of a larger tract that was surveyed by Robert McCrea, D^y S^r on the 20th April 1770 for William Menoch, by virtue of two orders dated 3^d April 1769 & numbered 493 and 2761, the above described part of which tract, by virtue of several conveyances is now the estate of the heirs of the said Samuel Taylor dec^d.
