



Situate on a dividing ridge between the West branch of Susquehanna and Little Clearfield creek, about 4 1/2 miles South of Chinclclamush old town and about 4 miles West of the mouth of Little Clearfield creek, in Chinclclamush township Clearfield county. Containing four hundred and six acres and allowance for roads &c

Surveyed the 16th of June 1810, in obedience to an Order of the Board of Property dated September 26th 1809 for John Norris upon which a return of a Survey was made by John Canan Esq^r late Deputy Surveyor, dated the 21st of October 1794 of 410 Acres and 142 Perches &c, in pursuance of Warrant granted to Richard Martin dated the 4th of February 1793

To Andrew Porter Esq^r Surveyor General Charles Tregidway D.S.
 Note Richard Martin has no old corners nor lines, all made new since the resurvey
