



The above Draught describes a tract of Land in Tyson Township which was originally surveyed for William Smiley (in pursuance of an Application dated 21st of March 1768. N^o 4862 for 300^{as} granted to Robert Bunting) containing 251^{as} 113^{ps} & allowance. Surveyed 10th Nov. 1775 as per rough Draft appears; and now resurveyed for Benjamin McCord et al. and by extraordinary excess on all the lines it contains Five hundred sixty two acres sixty eight perches, and Allowance.
