



A Draft of a tract of land Situate on the Waters of the East Branch of the Tunkhannoc Creek. in Lenox Township Susquehanna County (formerly Luzerne) Containing One hundred and Nineteen acres & Seventy four perches besides the usual allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c. Bounded North West of and adjoining land Granted to Elizabeth Harris, and South East of and adjoining land Granted to William Gray. Resurveyed June 20th 1839. in pursuance of the copy of a Warrant Dated April 14th in the year 1793. Granted to John Higher

The above tract of land appears to be in dispute between Thomas H. Clyman & John Doud the said Doud took out two Warrants to cover this land on Dated 15th August 1838 the ^{other} Dated 15th Nov^r 1838. both of which I executed & made returns to the Surveyor Gen- on the 27th of Nov^r 1838. expecting that his claim was good But on the 16th of March last Mr. Clyman's Agent presented me with a copy of an Original Warrant Dated 14th of April 1793. to be executed on the same ground in the name of John Higher. not knowing how to act I wrote to the Surveyor Gen- for his particular instructions. Mr. Taylor wrote to me authorizing me to execute the last Warrant & make returns to him or his successor in office, together with particular... Respecting the property. There is three Improvements on ^{it} the first was made by Michael Wallsted in the year 1806. the second in the year 1821. & the third made in the year 1824. there are two dwelling houses on ^{the} premises. one only is occupied by Samuel ^{the} Bishop who claims no presumption Mr. Clyman ^{sent} me three Treasurers Deeds for this tract bearing dates 1804. 1805 & 1816. I also understood that the Deputy Surveyor who executed the original Warrant of John Higher did not make return of Survey to the Surveyor Gen^l office
