And the said Peter Kreutzger Devised the 1st Tract N^o. 1. Between his two Sons Andrew Kreutzger and Peter Kreutzger, and the part of Tract N^o. 1. Marked with the letter N: being since Patented to the said Peter Kreutzger Jun^r. And on a Resurvey had the 23rd day of January 1793. of the ^{then} part of Tract N^o. 1. which is Marked with the letter B: containing Fifty four Acres and One hundred and forty Nine Perches & the Allowance of Six p Cent. and the Tract N^o. 2. containing One hundred and four Acres and One hundred and twenty five Perches & the Allowance of Six p Cent. Together containing One hundred and fifty nine Acres and One hundred and four Perches & the Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads & Highways &c. Situate in Tulpehooken Township in the County of Berks
