



Draught of a tract of land situate on the South East side of the Lackawanna River, about two miles up a small Brook emptying into the Lackawanna River a little distance below Roaring brook in Luzerne County Penn<sup>a</sup> adjoining lands of William Wright and others, and containing four hundred acres and Allowance. Surveyed in Aug<sup>t</sup> 1789 on a warrant dated 1 July A.D. 1784. Resurveyed the 2<sup>d</sup> day of September, A.D. 1842.
