



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries Dated the 30th Day of October Anno Domini 1735 There is Survey'd unto James Silver five hundred and Thirty Acres of Land with allowance of Six p Cent in Lancaster County on the West side Susquehanna River and Begins at a Spanish Oak By Conedagmanett Creek Thence South Eight Degrees Easterly Three hundred and Twenty pches to a Black Oak Thence South East One hundred and Twenty pches to a White Oak Thence North fifty five Degrees Easterly Two hundred sixty pches to a hickery a Corner of James Laws Land Thence North Eight Degrees Westerly One hundred & forty four pches to the 1st Creek To a Walnut Tree Thence up the sd. Creek Traversing the several Courses thereof about Seven hundred and Eighty pches to the place of Beginning — Survey'd Nov^r 19th 1735
