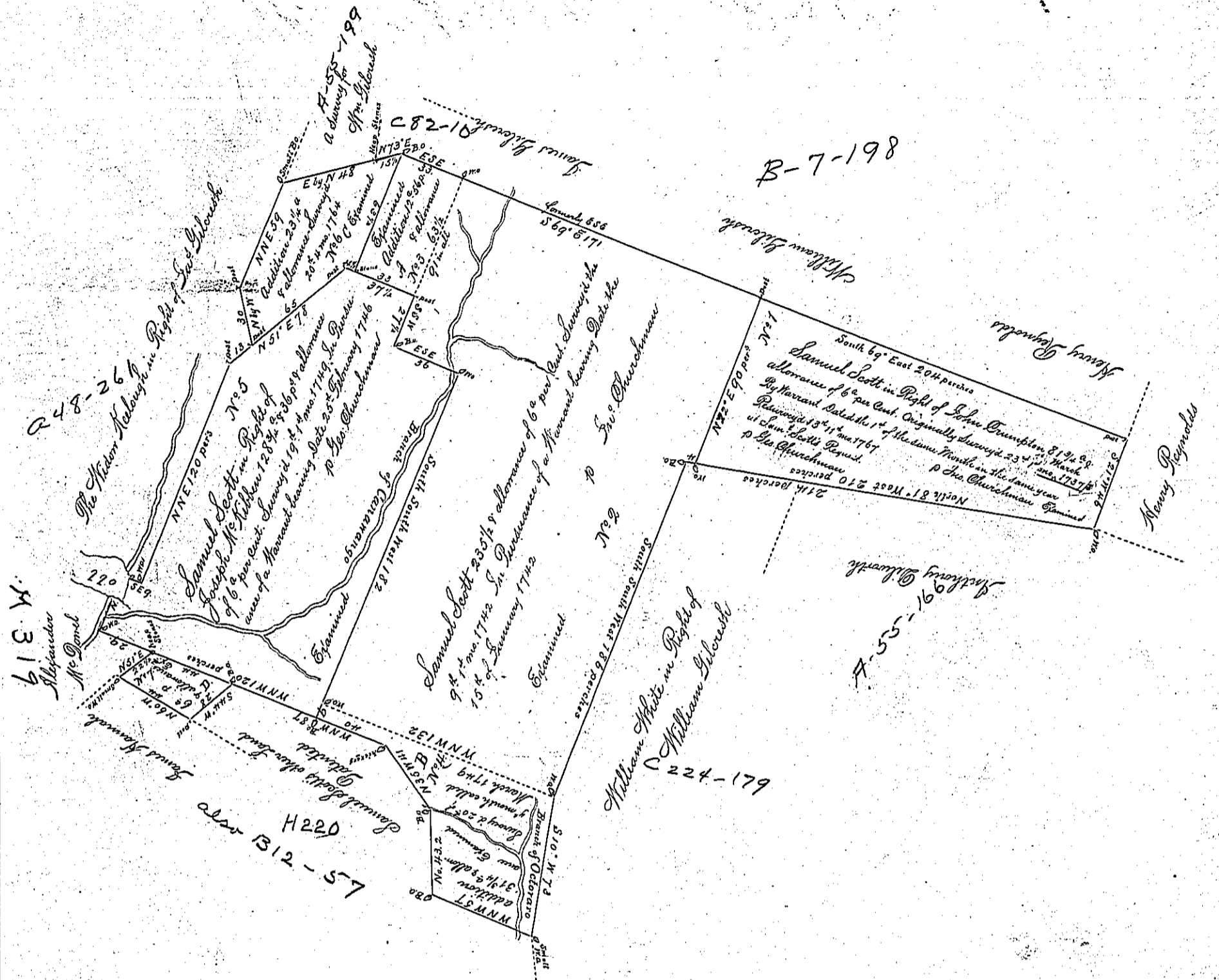

This Draught describes seven Tracts or Parcels of Land in Possession of Samuel Scott, situate in Little Britain Township, Lancaster County, which he desired to have exhibited in one Return, tho' all except the Addition D. were heretofore Returned, Containing in the whole 519 1/2^{ac} & the Allowance of 6th per Cent.

The Additions Marked A & B were Survey'd by Warrant bearing Date the 25th February 1746.

The Addition C. by a Warrant bearing Date the 8th of March 1759. &

The Addition D. 6th per Cent. In pursuance of a Special Order directed to me, after a hearing at the office on a Dispute between the s^d Sam^l Scott & his Neighbour Alexander M^o Dowell, ^{hearing Date in the month called April 1766} Returned on his ~~Application~~ ^{Request} ~~Warrant~~ ^{Warrant} dated the 13th April 1766.
