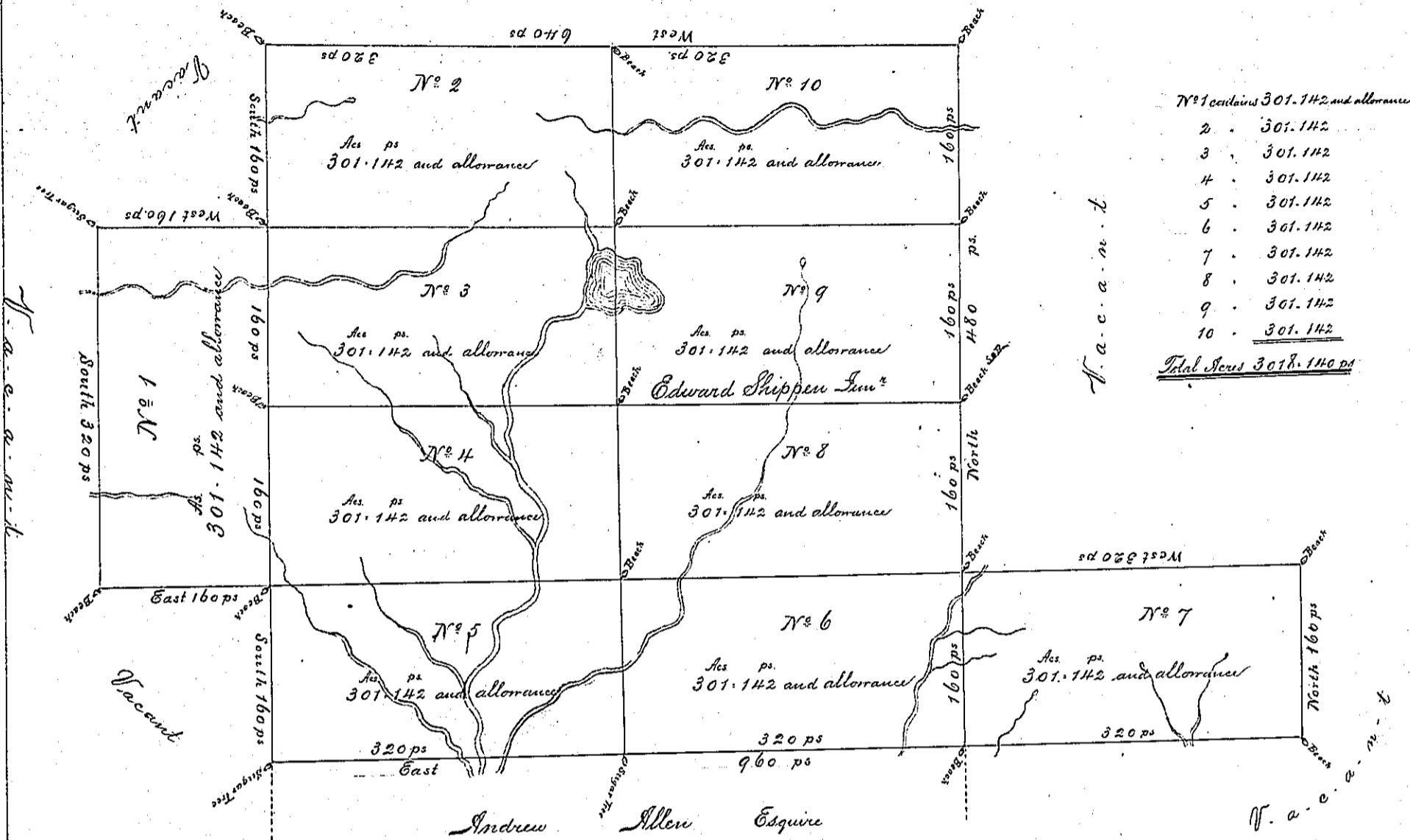

Trunkhamock Creek adjoining land Granted to Andrew Allen in the County of
Northumberland including within the Bounds of this Survey the Tracts or Lots
Numbered 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 & 10 as represented on this Draught and containing
in the whole the Quantity of three thousand and Eighteen Acres, beside the usual allow-
ance of Six p cent for Roads &c *and One hundred and forty perches*
Surveyed the first second and third days of October
1775 for Edward Shippen Junior. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 20th day
of August 1774

 To *John Lukens Esq^r Survey^r General*
