



A draught of a tract of land situate in Milford township Mifflin County appears surveyed the 24th day of July 1767 said to contain 1142 3/4 acres N^o 3261 granted to W^m Irwin granted the 30th day of March 1767.

On the 15th day of August 1800 an addition was made to the above survey of 161 acres and 140 perches and the allowance which is shown to the south of the dotted lines on the above draught from the N.W. cor. of Dennis Christy pursuant to an order of the board of property in favor of Hugh Hardy dated the 5th day of August 1800 - and by virtue of the aforesaid appl^{ts} in the name of W^m Irwin directed to me for Execution - Land included in the above tract with the addition appears to be 305²/₃ 1 066 perches and the allowance of 6 p Cent for Roads &c
