



Situated on the East side of Monongalia River about two Miles from Crovies Ferry in Robberson Township Fayette County & Surveyed the 21st day of March 1786 In Consequence of a Certificate Granted by the Commissioners appointed to adjust the Claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia Georgia & Ohio of which the following is a true Copy -

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Yohogania Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Jonathan Pearce and Stephen Pearce Legates of James Pearce dec^d is Entitled to four hundred acres of Land in the County of Yoho- gania on the Waters of the Monongalia River to Include the Actual Settlement made by James Pearce in the Year One Thousand seven hundred and sixty nine also a right in Prescription to One Thousand acres adjoining thereto

Given under our hands at Cops fort the Eighteenth day of February 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth.
