N^o 2 represented by the dotted and black lines is a Draft of Atract of Land Surveyed for Samuel Lyberger by virtue of a Settlement made in the year 1798 - this tract interferes Thirty Acres and Eighteen perches with the John Doyle survey - Samuel Lyberger conveyed to Joseph Leidig whose Widow and heirs now own the land.

N^o 3 represented by dotted lines is part of a Draft of Atract of Land Surveyed for John Masters by virtue of a Settlement commenced twenty five years ago or in the year 1803 - this tract Interferes Eighty six Acres and thirteen perches with the John Doyle tract - John Masters conveyed to George Miller the present owner
