



A Draught of a Piece of Land, Situate in Paradise Township in the County of York, Containing 134<sup>ac</sup> & 41 perches & allowance &c. part of 174<sup>ac</sup> & 1/2<sup>ac</sup> & allowance &c. Which was recently surveyed on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of March 1793. by Henry Danner D.S. under John Forsyth D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>ac</sup> granted to Jacob Neave bearing date the 26<sup>th</sup> day of August 1752. Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1837. for John Roth, the present owner, who requested me to make return of the same for Confirmation
