



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 11th June 1703 to lay out unto Henry Child (original purchase of 1000 acres) the quantity of five hundred acres in the County of Bucks. Surveyed and laid out unto the s^d Henry Child a tract of Land in Plumsted Township in the s^d County Beginning at a Post at a corner of Widow Musgraves land. Thence North West by a Road three hundred twenty five perches and one quarter of a perch to a Post. Then by other land of the s^d Henry Child's North East two hundred forty six perches to a Post. Then South East by Francis Plumsted's land 325 1/4 perches to a Post by a White oak in the s^d Musgraves line. Then by the s^d line South West 246 perches to the place of Beginning. Containing five hundred acres.

By virtue of another Warrant from the s^d Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 15th June 1703 to lay out unto the s^d Henry Child 481 acres the remainder of his purchase of one thousand acres. Surveyed and laid out unto the s^d Henry Child a Tract of Land in _____ Township in the s^d County Beginning a Post at the corner of his other tract. Thence North West by a Road three hundred and fourteen perches and three quarters of a perch to a Black oak. Thence North East by Vacant Land two hundred forty six perches to a Post. Then by Francis Plumsted's land South East 317 1/4 perches to a Post. Then by his other tract South West 246 perches to the beginning. Containing four hundred eighty five acres. Laid out both the s^d tracts the ninth day of the fourth month 1701
