The present owners & occupiers are Samuel Mayer, Christian Torrey & James Wilson & wife. the proportions owned by each are inserted in the above Diagram within the Black dotted lines of their respective parts.

The Red dotted lines, represent a survey made in pursuance of a Commonwealth Warrant to Alexander Mc Bride Jr dated the 11th day of May 1786. containing 420^{as} 7 ps & allow^{ce} which interferes with the above survey to nearly the whole extent. & on which a Patent was obtained dated the 4th day of July 1786. all which is respectfully submitted agreeable to my contract under the Act of Assembly in such case made & provided.
