



Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Hamilton Township, Franklin County (formerly Cumberland) containing in all 314 Acres & allowances of six percent for roads &c. Surveyed 23<sup>rd</sup> October 1828, agreeable to lines formerly surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 1768 granted to Samuel Moorhead for 300 Acres of Land "including the improvement he purchased of — Moore joining the Lands of Thomas Patterson & Richard Peters and said Moorhead's other Land in Hamilton Township." And by virtue of a contract with the Board of Property for ascertaining surveying and returning unpatented Lands under proprietary rights &c.

Report. The black lined Survey marked A, C, D, & E denotes the Survey on the above Warrant. The Red lined figures marked A & B denotes a Resurvey made on an Order of the Board of Property, dated 1 June 1827, & on a Warrant to William Rankin dated the 10<sup>th</sup> of July 1752 - owned by Rev. John E. P. Penn - occupied Philip Steek not Pat.  
 The red lined figure marked D. Survey 10 June 1794 on Warrant to Sally Chambers dated 11 Dec<sup>r</sup> 1792, owned by heirs of Benjamin Chambers - die<sup>d</sup> unseated Land.  
 The triangle E. included with this Survey made 30<sup>th</sup> June 1786, on Warrant to John Meek dated 24<sup>th</sup> June 1785 held by George Chambers on said Warrant & patent.  
 The part marked C remains clear of interference & is owned & occupied by Peter Houser, Sam<sup>l</sup> Coy's heirs and Henry Poemer on Moorhead's Warrant. W. S. D.
