



Situate in Reading <sup>and Hamilton</sup> Townships Adams County being part of 221<sup>a</sup> 112 ps & all. Surveyed Jan<sup>y</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> 1818 by order of Survey granted to Daniel Slagle for 250<sup>a</sup> N<sup>o</sup> 5138 dated August ~~5<sup>th</sup>~~ 26<sup>th</sup> 1768. Divided from the residue same day for Daniel Slagle containing eighty seven acres forty nine perches & all. Daniel Slagle took out 2 warrants dated Dec<sup>r</sup> 15<sup>th</sup> 1792 for land in Reading Township one for 30<sup>a</sup> the other for 180<sup>a</sup> which appeared to have been taken for 234<sup>a</sup> of which 72<sup>a</sup> & 11 ps of this a part being the part of it which lies in Reading Township Conewago being the line. (see return of whole tract)
