



Situate in Greabane Township Adams County

- A. Being part of a tract said to contain 336^a & all or surveyed by Arch^d McClean D.S. March 3^d 1769 by warrant to William Douglass dated Feb'y 14th 1769. Divided from the residue September 10th 1810. Containing 118 ps & all or.*
- B. Surveyed September 10th 1810. In pursuance of a warrant to Adam Yeagy for 21^a. Dated August 29th 1809. Containing 21^a 84 ps & all.*
- C. part of a tract granted to John Lehn by order of survey for 100^a No. 80 Dated August 1st 1766. Surveyed Sept 10th 1810. Containing 1^a 82 ps & all which if included in B they will contain together 23^a 6 ps & all. but not returned*
- D. part of 336^a 154 ps & all. Surveyed October 7th 1809 by warrant to Mary Steel Dated March 22^d 1749. Divided from the residue same day Containing 6^a 124 ps & all.*
- E. part of 60^a 70 ps & all. Surveyed October 25th 1810. by warrant to John Lehn Dated May 19th 1752. Divided from the residue same day Containing 13^a 27 ps & all.*

The above 5 pieces I surveyed for Adam Yeagy containing together forty three acres one hundred & fifteen perches & all. As there is no return of Survey on John Lehn's Location you can perhaps include the small triangle C in Adam Yeagy's warrant as the terms are nearly equal.
