



I Patrick Scott do hereby release & grant bargain & sell

 two perches more or less "Ross" in the plot and do hereby request and direct that a
 patent be made to the said Elizabeth for the same from the Land Office of Penn-
 sylvania. Witness my hand & seal this 6th July 1818.
