



A Draught of a Tract of Land, Situate in North Codorus Township, York County, Containing as above set forth 126 Acres 136 perches, and the usual allowance &c. being a part of two Larger Tracts of Land. Granted to Matthias Rupp. — Protracted and laid down from different draughts, Calculated & examined, at the request of the present owner Conrad Beck, who wishes to obtain a patent for the same, this sixth day of October A.D. 1864.
