



Situate on the S.E. side of the Raystown Branch of Juniata adjoining the Bridge on the Tumpike Road at the Crossings. Containing 265 acres and 100 perches & allowance of six pt. of ac. Originally surveyed for Levi Martin on warrant dated the 21st day of March 1794 - And Resurveyed for Samuel Tate the 3rd day of February 1835 in pursuance of an Order of Resurvey granted by the Board of property dated the 1st day of September 1834.

The above Survey was Returned to the Surveyor General's Office the 18th day of February 1834, and on the 27th day of Sept^r 1837 John Taylor, Esq. then S. G. Enclosed the draught in a letter directed to me to correct some Error and Return it again to the Surveyor Gen^l's Office so corrected that it might be accepted and filed in said office as soon as practicable I now have made said correction and Return it to your honour for acceptance and placed with my Return of the above date
