



Situate in Hopewell & Shrewsbury Townships in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 109^{as} & 135 perches and Allowance &c Being part of a larger tract of 394^{as} & Allow^{ce} of Land which was originally Surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 22nd of the 12th mo. 1764. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 400^{as} Granted to Peter Miller bearing date the 27th day of November A.D. 1762. On which Warrant the said Wm. Matthews Certified that he had Surveyed & Returned another Tract of 249^{as} &c for Charles Deihl assignee of Peter Miller so that in the whole the said Matthews Surveyed on the said 400^a Warrant Granted to said Miller for s^d Charles Deihl in right of Peter Miller 643^{as} &c Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of Land on the 1st day of May A.D. 1811 For and at the request of Andrew Zeller the present owner who desired the same to be Returned for Confirmation.
