



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Tawn Township York County, held by William Gamble (or Gemmill.) The Pick'd Lines Describe a Survey of 54 1/2<sup>ac</sup> made in Pursuance of a Warrant directed to my Father Bearing Date the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1749. & Survey'd the 16<sup>th</sup> of the same Month: Since which Time Thomas Armor, <sup>Surveyor of that County,</sup> at the said Gemmill's Request has on the Strength of the same Warrant Survey'd the Tract described by the Black Lines, which Survey he desires to have substituted in the Room of the other. & I have here described both from Armor's field work.
