



Situate In Trough Creek Valley in Union Township Huntingdon County - containing Two Hundred and Fifty six acres and Allowance of six percent - Surveyed 23rd day of November 1783 on Warrant granted to Christopher Reiter dated the 21st day of November 1774 - No 1 represented by dotted lines is the draught of a tract of Land Surveyed for Wilkinson Lane on Warrant dated the 9th day of November 1784. This tract interferes fifty three acres with the Christopher Reiter survey - Wilkinson Lane conveyed to Henry Barkstresser Esqr. the present owner. The other dotted lines represent the draught of a tract of land surveyed the 6th day of May 1785 on Warrant granted to Azariah M^c Lane dated the 18th day of January 1785 - this tract interferes two hundred and three acres with the Christopher Reiter survey - Azariah M^c Lane devised the same to John M^c Claim, the present owner.
