



The above is a Draught of a Resurvey, made November 13th 1829, in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property, Dated October 20th 1829, granted to James Byers, and Tho. Byers, (Executor of Tho. Byers Dec'd.) The outside lines are marked, and represent ^{the} ground always claimed by the petitioners, and not claimed by other persons, and contains six hundred & fifty six Acres and Allowance. The Compartment, marked A, represents the ground satisfying the Warrant of the 16th of March, 1786, agreeably to its location, and Contains four hundred & four Acres & 117 perches & Allowance of six per Cent. The Compartment marked B, represents the residue of the land, to be appropriated to the Warrant of the 29th of December, 1796, and Contains two hundred & fifty one Acres, & 43 perches & Allowance of six per Cent. Situate in East Finley Township, W. County on the waters of Buffalo Creek.
