



Situated in Reading Township Adams—A was Surveyed May 12th 1791 by John Forsythe D.S. In pursuance of two warrants one to James Davison Dated October 18th 1744 the other to Michael Ackerman dated May 19th 1752 said to contain 155^a 92 ps & alle B was Surveyed October 11th 1752 by George Stevenson D.S. by warrant to James Davison Dated December 18th 1751 said to contain 22^a & all. but as the said Surveys does not take in all the land owned by Jacob Myers which is excluded by his other Survey and in one place runs foul of it which you may see by the dotted lines I have included them both in one Survey as above laid down including the vacancies and excluding the interference
