

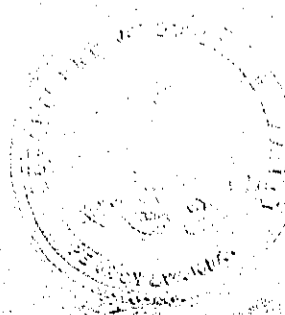

Said by Mr. Lukens, to be surveyed "according to the lines as run by George Stevenson," And now at the request of George Sheffer (who owns part of said land) the Draught is examined, corrected, calculated and returned for confirmation as the Official Work of the said Charles Lukens. - April 29th 1822
