



In pursuance of an Order of the Honourable Board of Property Dated the 14th of June 1787 I survey'd the Land Claimed by Mathew Killgore on the 22^d of the 9th mo. 1787 as above described Number 1 the Survey made and Returned by Wm Matthews to which No 2 is added containing in the whole 435^a 1/4 and allowance which Mathew desires to hold by Virtue of his two Warrants for 200 each, one in his own name dated the 9th of June 1769 the other in the name of John Mitchel and Charles Chara dated 10th of September 1750. No 3, 35 acres and allowance on his Warrant dated the 11th of March 1787 ^{all situated in Change of Township York County} ~~the dotted lines~~ represent a Survey made by Thomas Arumor for George Stevens on the 17th of March 1763
