A Draught of a Survey call'd Dawson's Choice, lying on the Waters of Racoon Cr. in Washington County containing 402 Ac. & 78 p. Strict Measures executed Jan'y 18. 1785 in consequence of a Certificate for 400 ac. granted to J<sup>r</sup>. Dawson by the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> appointed by Virginia to adjust the Titles to unpatented Lands in y<sup>e</sup> Counties of Monongalia, York & Ohio and regularly entered with y<sup>e</sup> County Surveyor as appears from the List of Entries transmitted from y<sup>e</sup> Surveyor General's Office
