



In pursuance of a Warrant Bearing date the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 1768 requiring me to Survey and lay out unto Joseph Fox the City Lots appertenant to George White's Original Purchase of 2500<sup>00</sup>. I do hereby Certify that I did on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1773 Survey for the said Joseph Fox the above described Lot of Ground situate on the North side of Nigh. or Market Street. Containing in Breadth East and West on Nigh. Street aforesaid Sixty Six feet, and in length North and South on the West side of the Eighth Street from Schuylkill three hundred and six feet
