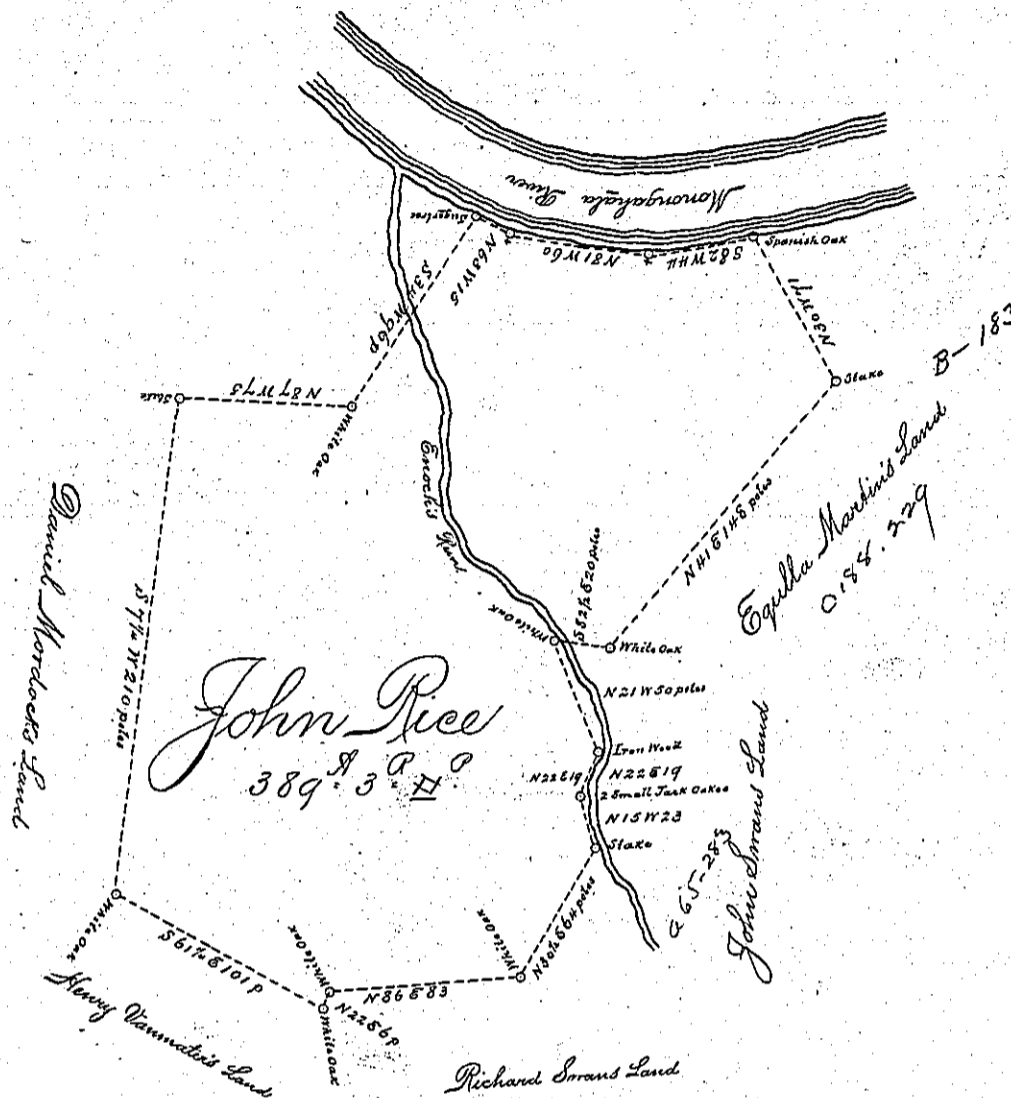

The above is a Draught of Land on the Monongahala River above the Mouth of Enoch's Run Called Prospect, Containing Three Hundred and Eighty Nine Acres Three Rods and Eleven perches, Surveyed, ^{July 11th 1785} for John Rice, on a Virginia Certificate as follows, viz:

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Land in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that John Rice is entitled to four Hundred Acres of Land in Monongalia County on the Waters of Monongahala River, to include his Actual Settlement Made in the year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy two Ent. 13th April 1780. Given under our hands at Coxes fort the Nineteenth Day of January 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
