N^o 1 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for John Gordon on warrant dated the 19th day of May 1792. This tract interferes one Hundred and twelve acres and forty five perches with the Joshua Archer survey. John Gordon divided the same to Thomas Gordon who also purchased the same from Samuel Piddle Esq who claimed under Joshua Archer and is the present owner.

N^o 2 represented by dotted lines is a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for John Gordon on warrant dated the 19th day of October 1792. This tract interferes Ninety six acres and seventeen perches with the Joshua Archer survey. John Gordon divided the same to Absolam Gordon who also purchased the same from Samuel Piddle, Esq who claimed under Joshua Archer.

N^o 3 represented by dotted lines is part of a draft of a tract of Land surveyed for John Gordon on warrant dated the 10th day of December 1790. This interferes one Hundred and Eighteen acres and thirty seven perches with the Joshua Archer survey. John Gordon conveyed to Jacob Bear who conveyed to John Gruver the present owner.
