



Situate in Lower Chanceford Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 39th x 137 perches and the usual allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 20 1/2 acres and allowance &c. Originally surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 11th day of November A.D. 1758. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Alexander McCannless bearing date the 6th day of May 1749. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land by William Kersey late D.S. on the 7th day of the 6th mo. 1791. And now at the Request of the owner Samuel Edgar the same has been examined, Calculated & found Correct, and at his request Returned for Confirmation the 20th day of January Anno Domini 1810th.
