The above Draught describes three Parcels of Land in Possession of William Gibson which he Purchased of Benjamin Dilworth & which were all formerly Survey'd for said Dilworth the addition at A above was Survey'd the 29th mo. 1751. In Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 11th of May 1750 & return'd in the year 1755 with the Tract of 103^{1/2} allowance above described; the other Parcel above described of 36^{1/2} allowance was Survey'd about the time of the addition of 16^{3/4} but not particular Warrant for it that I know of formerly held by Mr. Collin as above Noted. & William Gibson the present Possessor being desirous to Patent the whole together. I have annex'd the Draught thereof believing it may not improperly come under the same Terms as the other two Parcels as it appears to be indisputably his Right clear of any other Claim that I know of.
