



A Draft of a tract of Land situate in Cumberland Valley on Swifts Creek. Containing two hundred & forty three Acres & allowance. Situate in Cumberland Valley Township Bedford County. Surveyed for Daniel McCallister in pursuance of order No. 3190 dated the 25<sup>th</sup> March 1767 granted to him.

No. 1 a draft of a tract of land surveyed the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1790 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Barnard Dougherty dated the 17<sup>th</sup> April 1766. Interferes eight Acres & one hundred & thirty three perches & allowance with the Daniel McCallister tract. Barnard Dougherty sold to Charles Cessnae from whom it was sold by the Sheriff of Bedford County to George Elder, who devised the same to James Elder & John Elder who now own & occupy all the Barnard Dougherty except the aforesaid Eight Acres & one hundred and thirty three perches & Allowance, which are owned & occupied with the rest of the Daniel McCallister tract By John May's heirs
