



A Draft of four hundred and twenty nine acres and one hundred and forty one perches of land with six per Cent for Roads situate in Devry Township in Mifflin late Cumberland County which is one of the divisions of three adjoining tracts, the above represented part appears to be the property of Theodore Memminger and the part represented by dotted lines as the property of the Heir of Joseph Swift. That marked No. 1. containing one hundred and eight teen acres and seventy nine perches is part of a tract of land surveyed in pursuance of an order of survey to Isaac Bartram dated 15th September 1766 said to contain 327 ¹/₁₀ acres. order numbered 1243; and the part marked No. 2. containing three hundred and fifteen acres and sixty two perches is a tract of land which was surveyed in pursuance of an order of survey to Anthony Cadwalader Morris numbered 1245 dated 15th September 1766 said to contain 313 ¹/₁₀ acres. Resurveyed and divided 12th August 1803. Examined 27th November 1815
